Riverland Community College doesn't just cater to the educational needs of adults. This summer Riverland is offering Kids' College, a summer enrichment program for children. It is co-sponsored with Albert Lea Community Education. The program is designed for kids entering 4th, 5th and 6th grades in the fall of 2012. They must be comfortable in a fast-paced learning environment. Classes will stimulate and encourage creativity, develop thinking and problem-solving skills and bring together kids who love to learn.

When and Where

Riverland Kids' College will be offered **July 23-27, 2012** in Albert Lea at Riverland Community College, 2200 Riverland Drive. The program starts at 8:30 a.m. each day with a large group gathering. Students will take two classes; the first meets 8:45 a.m. – 10:15 a.m., the second from 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon.

Tuition

The cost is \$75 per child for the week. This includes two classes, supplies (unless otherwise noted), refreshments, T-shirt and certificate. A limited number of scholarships are available based on financial need.

Enrollment

A minimum of 10 students must enroll before a course can be offered. Early registrants are more likely to be assigned to the courses they select, but due to some class cancellations and popularity of classes, first choices cannot always be honored. Students will be notified of their class assignments.

Campus and Classroom Behavior

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that facilitates instruction and the learning process. Disruptive students will be dismissed from the program without a refund.
