

How often can I run my DARS report from the web?

Audits may be run only once per 24-hour period of time.

What if my DARS report has the wrong major/catalog/year.?

If you get an audit with the wrong major, complete the [Change of Major](#) form and submit it to the Registrar's Office.

Is it possible to view my DARS report with a different major without having to change that information with the Registrar's Office?

Yes. You may request an audit for a different major by submitting a [DARS Audit Request](#) form to the Registrar's Office.

Does DARS include transfer work?

DARS does include transfer work for new students starting Fall 2003. Transfer credits evaluated before 2003 may be a part of your official record but not in DARS. Please notify the Registrar's Office and we will update your DARS.

Will DARS replace my Advisor/Counselor?

No. DARS is a tool designed to assist students and advisors/counselors. It enhances the advising process. The report will help you select courses and participate in building your academic schedule. It allows you to monitor your own progress 24/7. DARS will help your advisor/counselor anticipate and resolve any problem areas and provide further academic and career counseling.
