Effective March 13, 2024

The Associate of Arts degree will be awarded to students for successful completion of 60 semester credits. 40 of the 60 credits must be selected from the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) Goal Areas 1-10. The remaining credits consist of: CCLS1000 First Year Experience, 1 credit in Physical Education/Health and 18 elective credits which may consist of: additional MnTC courses, technical elective credits (maximum of 16) and/or any course with a number of 1000 or higher.

MnTC courses may meet requirements for more than one Goal Area, but credits are not earned twice.

Transfer grades of A-D are included in the MnTC GPA.

MnTC cumulative GPA required to graduate: 2.0 or higher

Overall cumulative GPA required to be awarded the degree: 2.0 or higher
