# Practical Nursing Program Application Information and Checklist

Riverland Community College is asking you to provide private information in order to process your application form. This information will be used during the program application review. You are not legally required to provide this information; however, the college may not be able to effectively process your request if you do not provide sufficient information. Access to this information will be limited to school officials. Under certain circumstances, federal and state laws authorize release of private information without your consent to state and federal agencies or as otherwise permitted by other state and federal laws.

## Admission Criteria:

- Admission to the program is based on completion of the ATI TEAS (in person only) within 3 years of application and is ranked on the "Adjusted Individual Total Score". The percentage for each applicant will be ranked highest to lowest until seats are filled. The "Adjusted Individual Total Score" is also categorized as Exemplary, Advanced, Proficient, Basic, and Developmental. *\*Student must achieve a minimum of **40.7%** "BASIC" category of the TEAS exam to be eligible to apply to the nursing program. "Developmental" does not meet entrance criteria. **The full report must be submitted with the program application. NOTE: ATI TEAS by ATI Testing online version is no longer accepted.***
- Applicants must have the following pre-requisites courses completed prior to the application submission with a grade of C or higher. BIOL1030 Human Biology, PSYC1240 Developmental Psychology, ENGL1101 Composition I or ENGL1102, and One credit elective.
- Applicants must be active on a nurse aide state registry and must include a copy with the program application.

\*\* In order for your application to be reviewed the following list will help assist you to make sure you have included all the necessary information with the nursing application.

- I have included a copy of my active nurse aide state registry with the practical nursing application.
- I have completed the ATI TEAS within the last three years and have included the **full score report** with the practical nursing application. The full report shows individual scores in categories for Science, Math, Reading. NOTE: Prior to program admission, correspondence will be sent to the email address you indicate on the application. Once accepted to the program, all correspondence will be sent to your Riverland student email address.

\*Students accepted into the practical nursing program are required to register and attend PNUR1200 Nursing Orientation in order to begin the nursing program. Orientation will take place 1-2 weeks prior to the program start.

Students accepted and enrolled in the Nursing Program will be required to complete a Department of Human Services (DHS) background study. The background study will be initiated through the Allied Health Department at the college. Students will receive further details including the DHS privacy practices notice prior to the study being initiated. An individual who is disqualified as a result of the study and whose disqualification is not set aside by the Commissioner of Health will not be permitted to participate in any clinical activities in a Minnesota licensed health care facility. Students not in compliance with due dates for background study completion will lose their place in the program. Additionally, students who are disqualified or fail to participate in the background study process will not be eligible to progress in the program.

The Riverland Community College Nursing Program reserves the right to deny admission to anyone who has been convicted of a crime (misdemeanor or felony) or is pending a criminal charge (excluding minor traffic violations.)
