To be considered for a seat in the Radiography AAS Program, students must:

- 1. Apply and be admitted to Riverland Community College:**
 - a. Riverland Community College Application: <http://www.riverland.edu/admissions/apply-to-riverland/>

- 2. Applicants must complete the Health Science Reasoning Test (HSRT).** This test must be taken at a Riverland Campus site only and must be in person. Applicants must achieve a score of 75 or higher.
- 3. Have the 9 prerequisite courses completed with a *minimum grade of "C" by or in the semester noted below:** Consideration of a seat in the Radiography program is determined by the grades (cumulative gpa) of only the 9 prerequisite courses listed below. The GPA is added to your HSRT score. Applicant pool is very competitive and seats are limited. There are no bonus points.

9 pre-requisites courses must each have a grade posted on an official transcript no later than end of Spring 2026:

1. BIOL1030 Human Biology
 2. ENGL1101 Composition I
 3. HCNA1100 Nursing Assistant (grade not included in cumulative GPA, but must be completed)
 4. PHIL1140 Healthcare Medical Ethics
 5. PSYC1240 Developmental Psychology
 6. SPCH1200 Interpersonal Communication or SPCH1310 Communication in a Diverse World
 7. RADT1200 Introduction to Radiologic Technology
 8. RADT1225 Radiographic Pathology and Medical Terminology
 9. RADT1245 Skeletal Anatomy
- 4. Log into [E-Services](#) and run your AA 2418 Pre-Radiography/Liberal Arts DARS to be sure all 9 prerequisite courses are showing as successfully completed.** (You will also see your *cumulative gpa of the 9 prerequisite courses)

The letter will be sent to the email address you indicate on this application. **Applications will not be accepted if postmarked, dropped off, or electronically submitted after the deadline date, if the application is incomplete, or if all 6 steps above have not been completed.** The Program reserves the right to review late applications should the program not fill.

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Riverland Community College is asking you to provide private information in order to process your application form. This information will be used for preparation during the program application review. You are not legally required to provide this information; however, the college may not be able to effectively process your request if you do not provide sufficient information. Access to this information will be limited to school officials. Under certain circumstances, federal and state laws authorize release of private information without your consent to state and federal agencies or as otherwise permitted by other state and federal laws.

Radiography Program Background and Drug Screening Requirements

Students accepted and enrolled in the Radiography Program must complete and pass a Department of Human Services (DHS) background study. The background study will be initiated through the Allied Health Department at the college. Students will receive further details including the DHS privacy practices notice prior to the study being initiated.

A background study is a screening to determine whether a person has committed a disqualifying act. A DHS background study includes a review of criminal history information maintained by the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) and records of substantiated maltreatment of a child or vulnerable adult and other applicable records. In 2014 a state law was passed to require background study subjects to be fingerprinted and photographed. Fingerprints of the study subject are required to conduct a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) record check. The study subject must receive clearance notification from DHS BEFORE providing direct contact. "Direct contact" means providing face-to-face care, training, supervision, counseling, consultation or medication assistance to the people being served by the facility.

The Riverland Community College Radiography Program reserves the right to deny admission to anyone who has been convicted of a crime (misdemeanor or felony) or is pending a criminal charge (excluding minor traffic violations.) It is also understood that conviction of a felony may be grounds for denial of eligibility to complete the ARRT licensure examination. The Riverland Community College Radiography Program reserves the right to conduct Drug Screening tests prior to admission to the program.
