Currently-enrolled students are be able to download Microsoft Office for FREE on their personal devices.

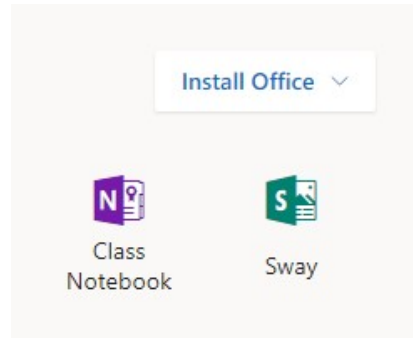
What software is included?



Want to use **Microsoft 365 (formerly Office 365)** on your personal devices for **FREE**? You can as long as you are a student of Riverland. Here are some easy steps to install it:

Using a web browser on the personal device that you want to install MS Office on, hover over My Riverland on the top menu, then select Student email on the drop down menu. Next, select Email Login, and sign into your email using your starid@go.minnstate.edu and starid password on the sign-in page.

Once you've signed in, look for the Install Office button on the initial page, usually above the Class Notebook and Sway icons in the upper right portion of your screen as pictured below.



Choose Office and follow their instructions. You will be able to install it on 5 personal devices such as PCs, Laptops, Tablets, and phones.

Remember, this is for personal devices only, not for college devices.

If you wish to just use the online versions of the applications like Word, Excel, PowerPoint, you can just click on those icons in the Apps area of your online Microsoft365 environment without installing the entire suite if you prefer.
