A. CARP 2270 Commercial Blueprint Reading II

B. COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Students in this course will further advance their commercial blue print reading skills. The students will study commercial plans and working drawings. This course is part of the Carpentry program which is accredited by the Home Builders Institute (HBI) and the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB). Prerequisite: CARP 2170

<u>CS</u>	read commercial plans.	1. locate correct information on various sections within a commercial plan. 2. locate information on a variety of sections within a complete set of plans, plot, elevation, floor plans, and details. 3. further identify various symbols and abbreviation correctly.
<u>CS</u>	read commercial specification books.	1. identify and review specifications to bid and build projects. 2. locate and read specifications from a specification book.
