

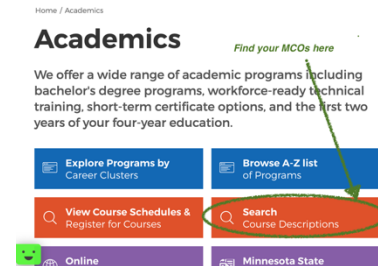
# CHOOSING A COURSE OUTCOME TO ASSESS

### IT'S AS EASY AS 1-2-3

**STEP 1: CHOOSE A COURSE AND LOCATE ITS MASTER COURSE OUTLINE (MCO).**

- go to [www.riverland.edu/academics](http://www.riverland.edu/academics)
- click "Search Course Descriptions"
- type in your discipline prefix and course number (ex: ENGL1107 or TRDR2140)



**STEP 2: CHOOSE AN OUTCOME TO ASSESS (SECTION E)**

    - Goal 5: History & the Social & Behavioral Sciences
    - Goal 6: The Fine Arts and Humanities
